This does not belong in the drain or the toilet:



Leftover food, fats and oils

They clump together in the sewer and cause noxious odours. They also attract rats.

When disposing of organic waste products, please use the bio-bin or your rubbish bin.



Solids and objects

They block the sewer, damage pumps and cause disruption at the sewage treatment plant. These include:

- cigarette butts
- textiles
- · toilet and baby wipes
- · cotton buds and pads
- · razor blades
- · tampons and sanitary towels
- nappies
- · condoms
- · cat litter
- plastics



Paints, varnishes and chemicals

These materials do not only pollute the water but can also form explosive gases in the sewer.

Please dispose of these materials at Berlin's public cleaning service BSR.



Medicines

Leftover medicines contaminate the groundwater and may endanger the quality of the drinking water.

Please bring your medicines to special waste collection points or to your chemist.

Use detergent and cleaning agents sparingly. Sanitary cleaners for the toilet are considered to be particularly aggressive. They are also usually unnecessary. A simple all-purpose cleaner and a toilet brush eliminate the dirt just as well. They thus benefit the environment and your wallet.
